*The Following is from "The Bad Catholic's guide to Good Living," by John Zmirak and Denise Matychowiak.*

*Sibyllina Biscossi (1287-1367); Patroness of Church Ladies*

*This reclusive, orphaned, housebound saint was blind and lived bricked up in the walls of a local church in Pavia. After losing her sight at age twelve, she was taken in by Third Order Dominican women and invited to join their community. She accepted and gained a reputation as the most prayerful nun in the cloister. But this wasn't enough for Sybillina, who'd developed a close friendship with St. Dominic himself, founder of the order. She prayed to him regularly to get back her sight, and one day he appeared to her in a lengthy vision in which he explained that god had answered her prayer. And the answer was no.*

*Undaunted, Sybillina increased her devotion, gaining permission to live as an anchorite—a hermit, locked up in a tiny cell adjoining the parish church. She suffered in the winters and lived on practically no food, communicating with the world only through her window—through which she would occasionally speak, accepting prayer requests and working miracles. Needless to say, she became a popular attraction in the town. Although she had no physical sight, Sybillina had been granted spiritual visions and a keen sense of the presence of God. Once she heard a priest passing by to bring the Eucharist to the sick, and she called out the window to tell the priest that he was carrying unconsecrated hosts. He sighed, shook his head, and agreed to check—only to find that in his haste he'd grabbed the wrong container.*

*Sybillina is the rightful patron of little old ladies who hang around the rectory, critiquing the priests' sermon, his choice of vestments, his choir director, and infidelity to liturgical directives from the Vatican.*
