RULES FOR HONOR GUARDS:

Simply stated, we would like Knights to be dressed in full regalia for all events; however, we understand that exceptions are sometimes required. Normal participation in Honor Guards requirements are as follows:

1. Must be 4th Degree member
2. Must have and wear a tuxedo
3. Must have regalia (cape, chapeau, sword, baldric, gloves)
4. Must be present at the "Event"
5. Must be dressed in full regalia.

When Exceptions are Permitted:

1. Medical or physical conditions preclude full participation in regalia.
2. An accidental exception might be granted at the discretion of the Marshal/Captain/Commander if other conditions are usually met, but an item (gloves, cape, etc.) were inadvertently forgotten.
3. Regalia must be owned or ordered for an exception to be granted. (Priests are exempted if their only participation is to be in a liturgical role.)
4. The Knight must be present.

Standard Exceptions- - Exceptions to the Tuxedo rule include:

1. Priests in liturgical vestments participating in the service
2. Transitional Deacons in liturgical vestments participating in the service.
3. Permanent Deacons in liturgical vestments participating in the service.
4. Servers in liturgical garb participating in the service.
5. Choir members wearing choir robes. (If the choir permits suits, the Knight should wear his Tuxedo.

*An American flag pin and "standard" 4th Degree pin
Are to be worn on the left lapel.
